

CAA Professional Development Fellowship Program 2008 PhD Application Form

About the Program

The College Art Association's Professional Development Fellowship Program, which began in 1993, supports graduate-level students in visual art and art history from socially and economically diverse backgrounds who may have been underrepresented in their field. By offering financial assistance to promising PhD students, CAA hopes to facilitate the transition between their graduate studies and professional careers.

Each fellow receives a one-time award of \$15,000.

Are You Eligible?

CAA encourages applications from all PhD students in art history from socially and economically diverse backgrounds who:

- Are citizens or permanent residents of the United States
- Will complete their dissertation and receive their PhD degree in the 2009 calendar year
- Demonstrate financial need
- May have been underrepresented in their field due to race, religion, gender, age, class, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, or financial status
- Have outstanding capabilities and experience and demonstrate distinction in approach, technique, or perspective in their contribution to the discipline of art history

- Essay: All applicants must submit a personal statement of no more than five standard, double-spaced pages and a font size no smaller than 12 point. All questions must be answered in narrative form. Essays that do not follow these specifications are disqualified from review. Please respond to the following points:
 - Discuss your educational background and current work
 - The purpose of the fellowship is to strengthen and diversify the field of art history. Discuss your eligibility, relating how your scholarship and personal history can make a positive contribution to the profession
 - Outline your career goals, relating how this fellowship's emphasis on professional development fits into your future plans
 - Discuss your current financial situation and how the fellowship would benefit you
- Your current résumé
- Dissertation prospectus
- Sample completed chapter
- Timetable for dissertation completion

3. Please include the following in HARD COPY:

- A completed 2008 PhD Application Form
- Three letters of recommendation from faculty members or employers, including one from your academic advisor. (These letters should be included in your packet and not mailed separately.)
- One copy of your most recent Free Application for Student Federal Aid (FAFSA) form or 2007 Internal Revenue Service income-tax return

- ❑ An official copy of your current graduate transcript
